What would you find in it and why? 20pts	Create a text message conversation between two characters from your book. <i>Pick 1 event</i> 30pts	Consider how the author's life may have influenced how he/she wrote the text. <i>2 paragraphs</i> 30pts	Write an epilogue for the book or write an alternate ending for the book. <i>5 paragraphs</i> 40pts
List parts of the text that appeal to each of the five senses. <i>2 sentences per each sense</i> 10pts	Sequence events from the text on a timeline. <i>Create a Timeline w/1 sentence description per event</i> 20pts	Write a test/quiz for the book. Include 20 questions and create an answer key. 20pts	Pick a scene that is described in detail in the story. Draw a detailed picture and then write your own description of what is happening. 30pts	Make a hypothesis about what may have changed if a character were in a <u>different setting</u> in the book. <i>3 paragraphs</i> 30pts	You have been hired by the local community to create a mural of graffiti on a major city wall. Your job is to create a collage of things that represent your novel. 50pts
Write an interview for a main character of the book. Ask at least 5 questions and write the answers to the questions, as the character would respond. 10pts	Design a new cover for the book. <i>Must be colored</i> 20pts	Develop a <u>visual</u> presentation to justify the actions of a character. <i>Video, diagram, etc</i> 20pts	Write a critique of the book – give examples from the text as evidence. <i>3 paragraphs</i> 30pts	Make a prediction of a character's life in the future. Think about: Where will he/she live? What kind of job or career will he/she have? Will he/she still be friends with the same friends as before? Will he/she get married? 30pts	Imagine that this book is a musical. Create a play list of 10 modern day songs and explain how each relates to the book. Then create and color a CD cover for your new album. 50pts
Suggest a solution to a problem from the text. <i>1 paragraph</i> 10pts	Write a summary of the book or chapter that you read. <i>2 paragraphs minimum</i> 20pts	Choose a character and imagine you walked into his/her room. What would you find in his room and why? <i>2 paragraphs</i> 20pts	Identify something a character has done and justify the actions of the character in the book. <i>2 paragraphs</i> 30pts	Research this specific time period and write 3 paragraphs evaluating how true the events of the book are to the time period. 40pts	Create a diary from any character's point of view. <u>Pick 5 important events</u> from the book to create a journal. You need 5 separate entries that capture that character's personality. <i>6-8 sentences each</i> 50pts
Demonstrate how nature played a role in events from the text. <i>1 paragraph</i> 10pts	Use a flow chart to explain several key events from the text. 20pts	Create a chart with symbols that represent a person from the text. Give the meaning of each symbol. 20pts	Critique the motives of the characters in the text. <i>Pick 1 character</i> <i>3 paragraphs minimum</i> 30pts	Research an event from the book and make a storyboard to explain what you found. 40pts	Select a character from the book and design a social media page for that character <i>Facebook or Instagram</i> 50pts
Pick 15 words from the book that you are unfamiliar with – write down their definitions. 10pts	Compare two characters from the text using a VENN diagram. 20pts	Retell a major even from the story from a different characters point of view. <i>2-3 paragraphs minimum</i> 30pts	Rate the actions of 3 people from the text. Explain why you rated each one this way. <i>3 paragraphs</i> 30pts	Whose I-Phone is this? Pick a character and figure out what would be on their I-Phone 40pts	Write a summary of each chapter and then create a PowerPoint slide for each one – add clipart to illustrate each of the slides. 100pts
